



Skin Cancer Signs & Symptoms

- The most common sign of skin cancer is to see any type of change in your skin. Examples include: a sore that doesn't heal, a growth, or a change in an existing mole.
- For melanoma specifically, you can remember this:
 - A – asymmetrical. *Does the mole or spot have an irregular shape?*
 - B – border. *Is the border irregular/jagged?*
 - C – color. *Is the color uneven?*
 - D – diameter. *Is the mole or spot bigger than the size of a pea?*
 - E – evolving. *Has the spot changed recently (weeks/months)?*

Skin cancer will look different on different people, so it is important to be aware of what is normal for you. You should talk to your doctor if you notice a new growth or sore, any of the ABCDEs of melanoma, or any changes in your skin.
