Worship March 8th

Jesus overturning the tables in the temple courtyard (wielding a whip, no less!) is considered "Out of Character" by some, while others may seek to justify violence based on Jesus' actions. The placement at the beginning of his ministry in John 2:13-22 contrasts with the Holy Week setting in other gospels, yet allows us to ponder exactly where and how we know the presence of God. The Ten Commandments in Exodus 20 and Paul's words on faith and foolishness in I Corinthians 1:18-25 round out the week's texts.





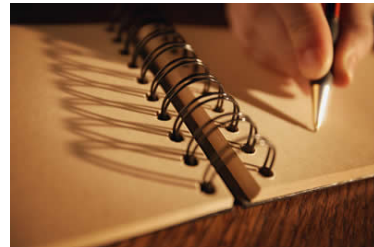
DAYLIGHT SAVINGS TIME

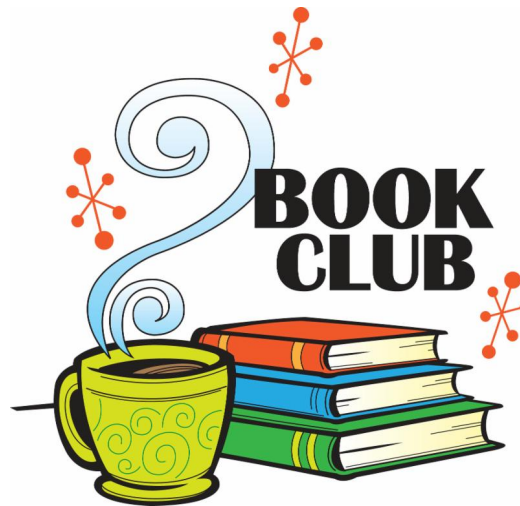
Easter Lilies and Spring Flowers

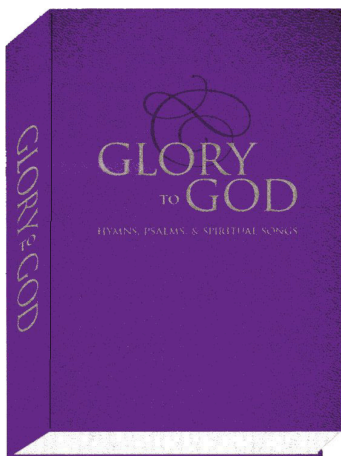
Gather a group of colleagues, friends, fellow parishioners, family members, or strangers - ALL AGES WELCOME!
