Men's Breakfast and Bible Study

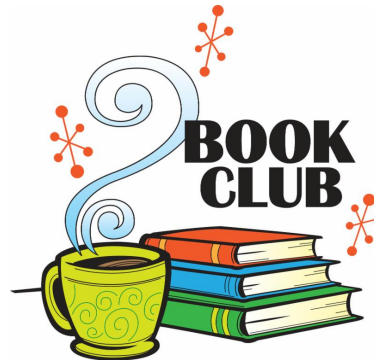
at 6:30am on Friday, April 10th.

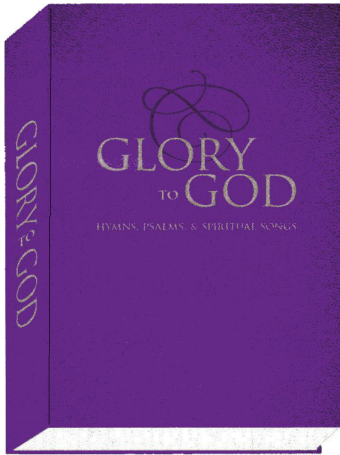
