Good news! I have found where he is. The police guards and prisoners were so helpful. Some of them remembered him and knew where he had been sent. He is in a high security prison for long term and life sentences. The prison is 6-8 hours by bus from where I live and is on the Vietnam border. Very remote. I have made some enquiries about gaining permission to visit him. As always - difficult. I was told that no foreigners go there now and they have not allowed foreigners to visit in the past.

I have let Henri know and he is delighted.

This will need much prayer, but we trust in our God.

Daily yield from our 1 hectare garden is now 300kg per day. God has truly blessed this work. It is so rewarding for the prisoners to know they are providing food for almost all the prison.

I have done one clinic since returning to Cambodia on 1st January. Main problem at the moment is scabies because of overcrowded conditions.

DENTAL CLINIC will resume as soon as we get our new agreement from the government to continue the work.

Over 60 prisoners at last Mondays bible class sitting on new chairs which I had bought for our very own classroom.



I always enjoy giving out food to the Bible class. I varied it this week with a tin of fish and a packet of noodles. A whole meal!

- *The journey to reach Mongrie has just begun. For our God to open the doors and soften the heart of his prison director to allow me in. Henri will provide monthly support if I can arrange it.*

- *For more humane treatment of all prisoners. I learned from 'one who has been there' that 20 prisoners are locked in the 5x5 metre cells 24 hours. They must sleep in bent position and all have scabies.*
- *Thanks to God for a lovely apartment He has provided for me in the town. Also I have a motor bike – God has provided for all my needs.*

Thank you to all my supporters. Gods' love through the gospel will continue to be brought to these needy prisoners through your generosity.
