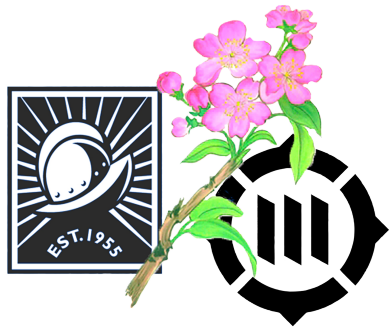

Eligibility

Current students from Cupertino schools, 5th - 12th grades.

Guidelines for Artwork

Must be unsigned, original and exclusive work by the artist for this contest only. Size: up to 14" x 11", in Portrait orientation. Must be flat, 2D and dry, and matting is fine. Drawing or painted pieces must be scannable. Digital, vector image file is fine. May submit up to three pieces, but each piece requires a separate entry form. Artwork will not be returned. Include artist's name, school, parent's email and phone number on the back on a separate piece of paper.

How to Submit - Must complete both steps

1. Email a photo of the artwork as a reference to the address CupertinoToyokawaSisterCities@gmail.com with the subject of "Artwork Submission - Your name". This can be a cell phone photo or a scanned photo.
