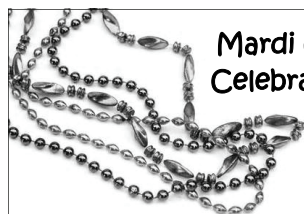


### Not Over Yet!

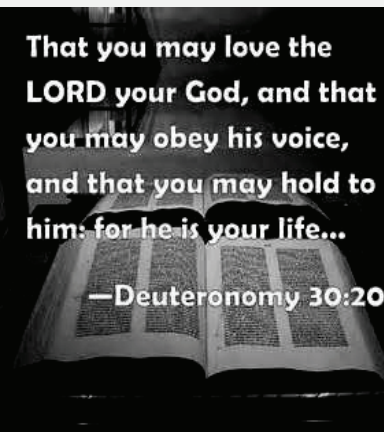
