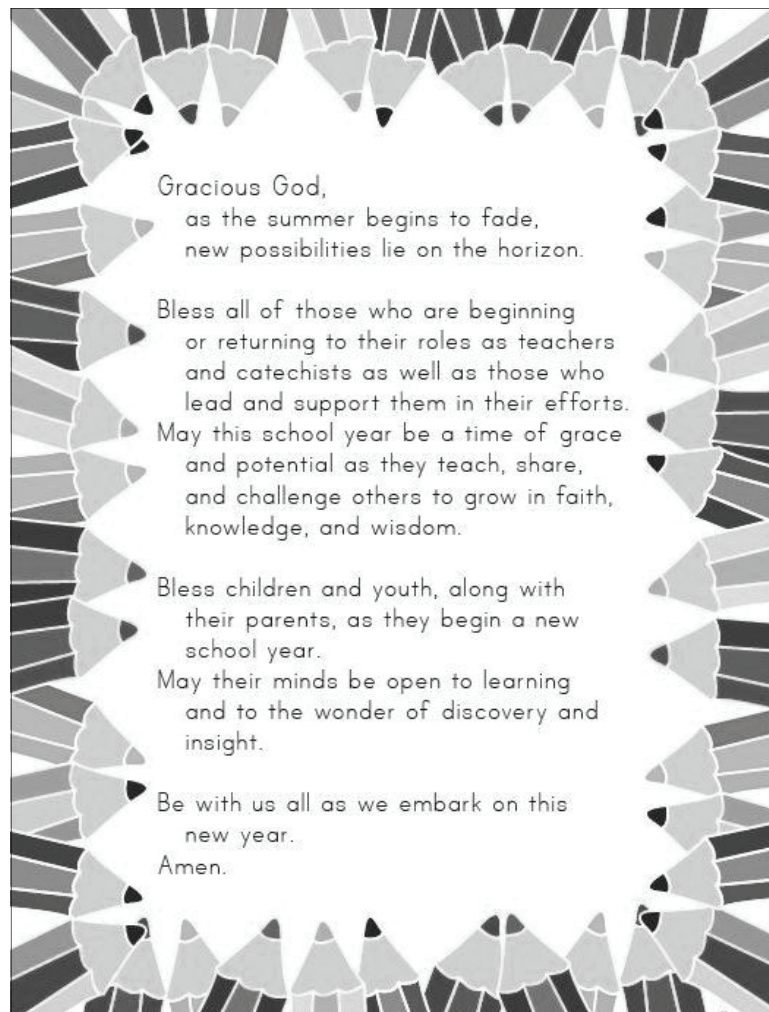

In the event of a threatening disaster, each person that has submitted a form and is approved as a person who meets the eligibility criteria of a Special Needs Shelter will be contacted from a Chowan County Social Services official to help plan for his/her safety during that time.

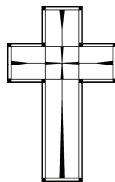
