On **Wednesday, July 27**, the Associate Pastor Search Committee will be present at 6:30pm in the fellowship hall to answer any questions you may have about Patrick. Previously approved details about compensation and benefits for the Associate Pastor will be reviewed. Then, the church will meet in a called conference the following **Sunday, July 31**, at 10:45am, to vote on Patrick.

For members unable to be present in the called conference July 31, absentee votes may be submitted in the church office **Monday, July 25 through noon on Friday, July 29**. Absentee voting forms will be available in the church office. The completed form will be folded and placed in an envelope supplied by the church. The envelope will be sealed and signed by the person voting and submitted to the church office. The Church Administrator will secure all submitted forms, unopened, and deliver them to the Associate Pastor Search Committee. The committee will verify that each signed envelope is from a church member. The envelopes will be opened, and the forms removed and placed in the collection box without revealing the votes. The absentee voting forms will then be counted in the final tally, with no identification of the person voting.

The Associate Pastor Search Committee is thankful for the prayerful support that has been offered to them throughout the search process.

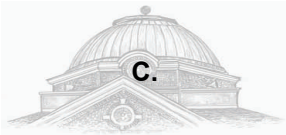
