

MEDICAL CODING TECHNOLOGY

The Medical Coding Technology program prepares individuals for entry level employment in the area of coding and billing for health care facilities such as physicians' offices, long-term care facilities, hospitals, and in home care agencies. Some of the areas of study include medical terminology, medical law and ethics, coding for diagnosis and interventions and all aspects of coding medical claims.

Emphasis will be placed on reviewing medical documentation provided by physicians and other health care providers and translating this information into numerical codes. In addition, using this coded data for payment of claims, statistics, and medical research.

Progression is dependent on maintaining a C or better in all courses. The certificate in Medical Coding Technology is awarded by the College upon completion of this program.
