To access the digital programs, you can click on the links below to view on your computer or tablet in your web browser.

The best way to view them is using a **free app called 3D Issue**. It is available in the Apple App Store and on Google Play. Download the app first. After the app is installed on your smartphone or tablet, open the link for the program for your convention site on the smartphone or tablet. If you opened this e-newsletter on your computer, you will need to forward it to your smartphone or tablet and open it there. Note that after it is downloaded in the 3D Issue app, you will not need an internet connection to view the program.

## Attention Louisville Attendees

For Louisville attendees, since some will be staying somewhere other than the Marriott because we were unable to get more rooms there this year, we want to remind everyone to be safe when out walking at any time of the day or night. We appreciate the understanding and cooperation with everyone involved in this endeavor.
