

# Call for Entries



Held in conjunction with Saskatchewan Design Week, taking place in Saskatoon from September 23–29, 2017, the Premier's Awards of Excellence in Design is a juried competition recognizing outstanding applied design in Saskatchewan in seven different categories

## Eligibility

Open only to certified individuals and/or corporate members who are in good standing with their DCS member association.

All projects must have been:

- designed, built, substantially complete, and/or implemented in Saskatchewan between Nov 2015 and Aug 2017.
- designed by licenced, registered, or certified designers (or team of designers) who are permanent residents of Saskatchewan and are licenced, registered, or certified with a Canadian or provincial certifying body in Saskatchewan and were the lead designer. Licence, registration, or certification documentation must be submitted with entry.  
ie.) SAA & IDAS: Registration #, SALA: Full Member Certificate # ; APEGS: P. Eng. Licence #, GDC: CGD Certification #, SPPI: RPP Member #.

The integrated design category should demonstrate significant collaborative involvement of three or more member associations throughout the project and cannot be entered in any other category.

Each applicant may submit more than one entry.

Validity of design entries will be reviewed by the Design Council prior to judging. Please ensure you have reviewed and met all the required criteria.

Submissions with a lead designer that is not an eligible, stamped member will not be eligible for award. Only eligible members presented as the lead designers in any category will be presented with an award.

ie.) Only lead Registered Architects will be presented with an award in the Architecture Category.

## Judging

The jury is composed of one representative from each member association and may include invited guests from the Speakers Series and/or a member of the public.

Entries will be judged on criteria appropriate to each category. However, the common theme will be value and excellence in design in Saskatchewan. See the judging criteria on our website.

Each entry will be judged in its respective category. However, entries in the integrated design category that the jury deems to lack sufficient evidence of collaboration may be relocated into other specific categories.

One Award of Excellence, Certificates of Merit, and Honourable Mentions may be designated in each category at the judge's discretion.

The Premier's Awards will be presented on Friday, Sep 29, 2017. (Details to follow.)

## Submission Format

For display purposes, all entries must be securely mounted to a light, rigid board (such as foam core).

Entries may consist of professional quality photos, illustrations, plans or printed samples.

Maximum of two (2) panels per entry.

No entrant identification on front. Display IDs will be added after judging.

Each entry must include, as part of the front of the display, a brief design statement (750 words for the integrated design category and 250 words for all other categories) outlining the design objective and any other pertinent information which supports the Design Council of Saskatchewan's mandate.

The attached Premier's Awards Entry form must be copied and secured to the back of each panel.

Please provide high resolution (300 dpi) JPGS and PDFs of the entries for possible presentation and publication on a disc or USB (preferred) or email to your DCS representative (listed below).
