

Worship Arts: Youth Ministry Audio Engineer

Goal(s): To create a dynamic and engaging worship environment for youth students to encounter God and worship Jesus.

Time Commitment: 2.5 hours on the specific week you're serving

- Commit to serving at least once a month for either a high school or middle school Sunday evening gathering
- Sundays: 3:00-4:00pm (rehearsal) & 5:00-6:30pm (youth gathering)
- Bi-Monthly Worship Family Nights: 2 hours (location and times vary)

Responsibilities:

- Arrives 15 minutes before the band to ensure equipment is set up and ready to make noise.
- Stays shortly after gatherings to play music and shut down front of house.
- Be on time, ready to give God your absolute best at every opportunity
- Ensure mix and volumes sound as good as possible
- Listens critically to everything and willing to give helpful feedback
- Flexibility to think quickly on the fly and follow the teaching or music
- Respond promptly to schedule requests
- Communicate technical issues to the technical coordinator
- Be familiar with gathering flow to anticipate what's coming "up next" in the gatherings and execute accordingly
- Be a team player, able to receive training, instruction and feedback
- Shut down front of house after the young adults gathering
- Attend and participate in Worship Family Nights
