



**Jim Lambie b 1964**

*Dream Baby Dream*, 2011, aluminium and household paint

Jim Lambie makes much of his art from simple, everyday materials.

Make at least 4 equal sized squares from different coloured stiff paper or thin card – if you can find paper that has different colours on each side you'll get a bigger range of colours.

Using a small blob of glue, placed in the centre of the back of each square, stick the squares one on top of the other – keeping them lined up together.

Fold down the corners – starting with the top square. Continue to fold down the corners of the remaining squares. Each of the folds will get smaller each time.

The titles of Jim Lambie's artworks are often song titles or the names of his favourite bands. What will you call your artwork?
