

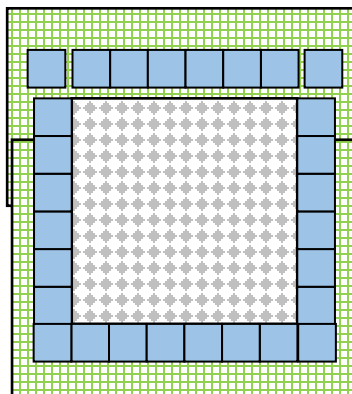
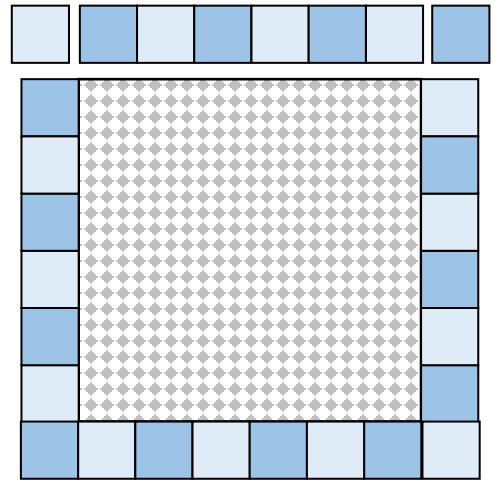
Pillow Panel — Makes 16" square pillow

Trim pillow panel to 12½". Cut 28 squares 2½", or use *Mini Charms*. Sew 6 of these together in a row.



Repeat. Press seams and sew to both sides of panel. Now sew 8 of these together to make a row. Repeat. Sew these to top and bottom of panel. Press as you go, taking care not to have hot iron directly on lettering of panel. Quilt with batting and muslin as desired, or leave as is.

To make pillow back, use 1/2 yard of fabric. Cut this along fold. Fold and press each of these in half, so you have two pieces that measure *about* 18" x 11". Lay one on the other, overlapping them about 5" at fold edges, so that raw edges are all around outside. Baste at the sides. With pillow top face up, lay on top of pillow back, with fold-over edges centered. Now trim pillow back to same size as pillow top. Baste around all four sides. Make 2½" wide binding strips and bind as you would a quilt. Finished!



Trim back so top and back are the same size.
