

Crib Sheet

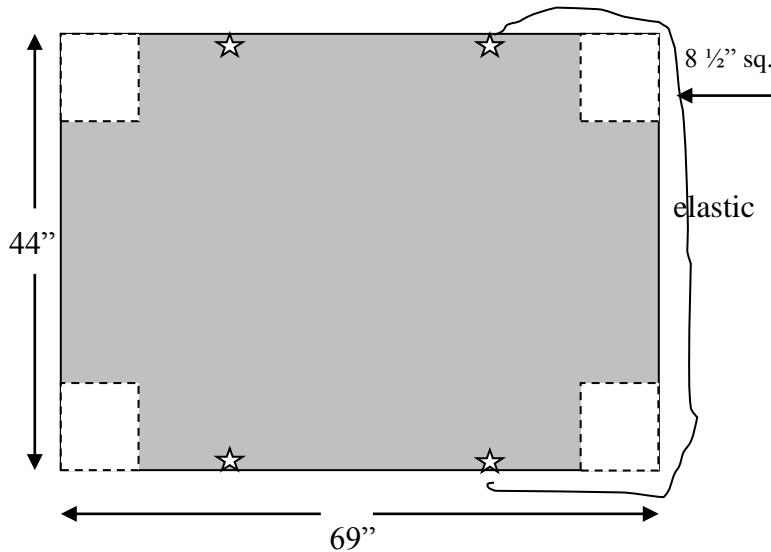
Standard baby mattress
27" x 51"



2 yards flannel or cotton, prewashed for shrinkage
1 ½ yards ¼" elastic

This is an excellent way to accent that special quilt; make a matching sheet for baby's bed!

- Cut fabric 69" x WOF. Fold this rectangle into fourths, matching corners. Cut 8½" square from corners as shown.



- At corner, pin the cut edges together, right sides together, and stitch, backstitching. Repeat at other three corners.
- Turn under and press ¼" around all sides. Turn under another ½" and press. Measure 12" from corner seam on each long side and mark with pencil or pin (see stars on diagram). Stitch from pin to pin on each *end* of crib sheet close to first pressed edge to form a casing for elastic.
- Using a safety pin thread 27" of elastic through stitched casing on each end of sheet; stitch across ends of elastic to secure. Topstitch the side turned-under edges of sheet between elastic.
- That's all there is to it!
