

Prairie Petite Basket Quilt



From basket/border print, cut:

- 2 strips 2½" x WOF for outer border
- 2 strips 2½" x WOF for binding

- 2 squares 3⅞"; subcut each diagonally once for 4 triangles.
- 12 squares 2⅜"; subcut each diagonally once for 24 triangles.

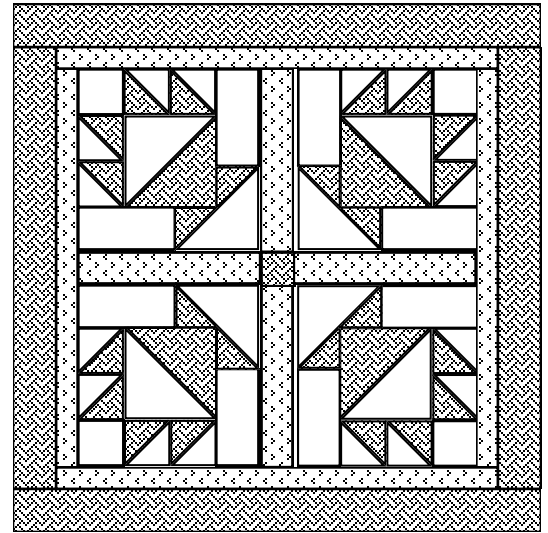
- 1 square 1½" for center of sashing

From background fabric, cut:

- 4 squares 3⅞"; subcut each diagonally once for 8 triangles.
- 8 squares 2⅜"; cut diagonally once to make 16 triangles.
- 8 rectangles 2" x 3½"
- 4 squares 2"

From inner border/sashing, cut:

- 2 strips 1" x WOF
- 4 rectangles 1½" x 6½"

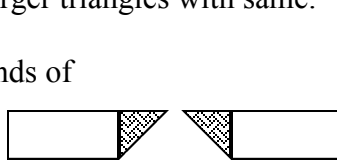


You may substitute Triangles on a Roll™ for the squares that are cut into triangles, or you may cut these squares a bit larger so that you can trim the half square triangles to the exact size which is 2".

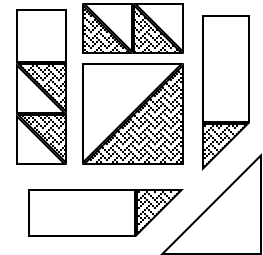
Make 16 half square triangles from smaller triangles with basket print and background.
 Make 4 half square triangles from larger triangles with same.



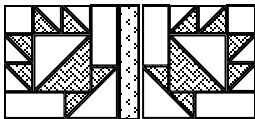
Sew 8 remaining print triangles to ends of
 8 background rectangles as shown,
 4 of each way.



Piece block together as shown at right, using the small and large half square triangles, the rectangles above, the 2" squares, and the remaining larger triangles.



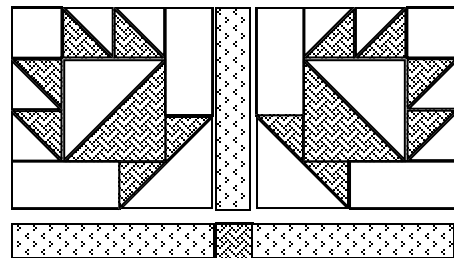
Sew 2 blocks together with a 1½" x 6½" sashing strip as shown; repeat.



Sew other 2 sashing strips with 2" print square.



Sew these 2 block sections together with sashing strip between them.



Sew inner border to sides of quilt, then outer borders. See picture at top of page.
 Quilt as desired and bind.
