




Lined Drawstring Bag



The construction is the same for any size bag. Use the chart to determine the cutting sizes.

Make any size bag chart (refer to diagram above)	
Determine the cutting measurements	
bag cut width	bag width + 1/2"
bag cut height	(bag height x 2) + 1/2"
lining cut width	bag width + 1/2"
lining cut height	bag height + (lining border height x 2) + 1/2"
drawstring cut length & width	bag width x 3 = length width = 2"

Example: The finished size of the bag is 10" width x 12" height, lining border height is 1".

Using the chart:


- Bag cut width: $10" + \frac{1}{2}" = 10\frac{1}{2}"$
- Bag cut height: $(12" \times 2) + \frac{1}{2}" = 24\frac{1}{2}"$
- Lining cut width: $10" + \frac{1}{2}" = 10\frac{1}{2}"$
- Lining cut height: $12" + (1" \times 2) + \frac{1}{2}" = 14\frac{1}{2}"$
- Drawstring cut length: $10" \times 3 = 30"$
- Drawstring width: 2"

The cutting for the bag is:


- Bag: 1-10½" x 24½" rectangle
- Lining: 2-10½" x 14½" rectangles
- Drawstring: 1-30" x 2" strip

Construction Use ¼" seams. RS=right side WS= wrong side


1 If you would like to embroider the bag, add the embroidery before constructing the bag. Layer the 2 lining rectangles right sides together to the bag rectangle, matching the lining to the ends of the bag. Stitch. Press the seams away from the bag.



2 Fold the bag and lining right sides together, aligning the sewn seams. Mark lines 1" and then ¾" from the center seam as shown. Stitch both sides of the bag. On the side with the marks, stop stitching and backstitch at each of the marks leaving an opening for the drawstring.





3 Turn the bag right side out through the open end. Stitch the lining end closed. Using a water soluble pen, mark lines 1" and then ¾" from the seam as shown on both sides of the bag.



4 Stuff the lining into the bag, leaving the height of the border of lining. Stitch on the marked lines around the bag and in the ditch between the lining and bag.

Fold the drawstring in half wrong sides together, press. Open, press the long edges to the middle pressed line, press. Fold in half again. Edge stitch the drawstring edges.



Use a safety pin to thread the drawstring through the bag. Tie the drawstring ends in a knot.
