# Trick or Treat Bag 

$111 / 2 " \times 12 \frac{1}{2}$ "

## 3 fat quarters

3/8 yard for lining
Use $1 / 4 "$ seams.
From 2 fat quarters cut 2 rectangles $6 " \times 12$ " for a total of 4
From 1 fq cut 2 rectangles $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 12$ ". Cut 2 strips $3 " \times 16^{\prime \prime}$ for handles

Sew strips together for bag sides as shown in diagram using.


Make 2 sides. Press seams
With right sides together, sew sides and bottom of bag.
Cut 2 lining pieces the same size as bag. Sew sides, and bottom leaving an opening for turning.
Make handles. They will finish at about $3 / 4$ " $\times 16$ ".
Pin handles to top edge of outer bag with outer edge of handles about 2 " from side seam.
Turn outer bag right side out; slip inside lining. Sew seam around top edge.
Turn right side out; stitch opening in bottom.
Press seam at top edge. Topstitch around top edge.

- If you cut bag sides. $10^{1 / 2}$ " or 11 " wide instead of 12 " you can probably get 2 bags from the 3 fat quarters and lining. Or piece together your scraps any way you like.
- Use 2 fabrics instead of 3. Or 1. Let your creativity guide you and have fun with these!
