Christmas Tree Napkins

½ yard of two different fabrics – to make 4 napkins

Coordinating thread

Using freezer paper, or your favorite method for making a circle, cut 2 circles from each fat quarter; 18" or 16". A pizza pan works well; we used the Circle Savvy Ruler from Creative Grids which is limited to 16", to cut the half circles.

Cut full circles in half. Two half-circles are required for each napkin.

Place two half-circles right sides together and sew with ½" seam, leaving a 2" opening at top edge. Use a smaller stitch length around the curved edge. Clip corners. Set seam with iron, then turn right side out and press well.

Topstitch all round napkin 1/8" from edge which will close the opening.

To fold the tree, fold accordion style until you are satisfied with the tree shape.
