Atelier de France quilt requires **2 Layer Cakes** and **1 Cake Mix #4**. Two LC squares are used together rather than a single background. This is why it takes more than one Layer Cake. The quilt is laid out 12 half square triangles wide and 15 half square triangles long for a total of 180 hst. Use at least 23 of the Layer Cake papers, but using more will give you more variety. 48" x 60" before borders.

Cut 7 border strips 5½" wide. **1¼ yard border fabric**

⅝ yard binding

If making scallops on the border, cut *binding* fabric on the bias 1¼" or 1½" wide strips, whichever you prefer. This is for a single binding, not double-fold.

You can easily make this quilt almost double the size by using the Layer Cakes and the Cake Mix up completely. More border fabric will be required, or leave off the border. Perhaps 16 blocks wide x 20 blocks long. 320 hst blocks

You can make this quilt with 1 Layer Cake if you make it a bit smaller, 11 squares wide and 14 squares long. 44" x 56" before borders. With a 5" outer border, quilt will be 54" x 66".

Add a 1½" inner border and 5" outer border and quilt will be 57" x 69".
