

Snowball Quilt

56" x 72"



Cut 63 squares $8\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " from yard dyes or prints.

Cut 252 squares $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $2\frac{1}{2}$ " from background.

Sew the small squares on 4 corners of the large square, snowball fashion. Press seams towards the triangles on 2 opposite corners, and press away from the triangles on the other 2 opposite corners. Lay out the blocks 7 per row, making 9 rows. Be sure to place so that the triangle seams will nest when blocks are sewn together. Add a border if you want, but mine turned out 56" x 72" without one.
