Beginning with the opening of school in 2016, Hapeville Charter Middle School and Hapeville Charter Career Academy will participate in the Provision 2 option of the Federal School Breakfast Program and National School Lunch Program. Under this program, **breakfast and lunch are served to ALL students at no charge regardless of income.**

**Applications are required** during the base year (1st year) of the program to allow the schools to feed all children at no charge. The three remaining years in the four-year cycle are based on the percentage of participation in this base year.

It is crucial that all participants complete the meal application so that the schools can correctly identify students who qualify for free and reduced meals. If the applications are not completed, it will be detrimental to the program and the schools would have to withdraw from participation. Students would once again have to pay for meals if this occurred.

It is very important that all students have the ability to eat a healthy breakfast and lunch so that they are fueled and ready to learn. It is our hope that the schools' participation in this program helps to further our students in their educational journey.
