Recruitment Timeline during the 2017-2018 School Year in preparation for the 2018-2019 School Year and Lottery Guidelines (if applicable:)

First week of January 2018	Mailing to currently enrolled 5 th , 6 th , 7 th , 8 th , and 9 th graders in the Fulton County School System. The target date for the recruitment mail drop is January 3, 2018
January 8, 2018 through February 15, 2018	Pre-enrollment registration of currently enrolled students at Hapeville Charter Schools
January 20, 2018 Postponed to January 27, 2018 because of snow days	Informational/Application Meeting #1 for prospective new students HCMS – 10:00am HCCA – 1:00 pm
February 24, 2018	Informational/Application Meeting #2 for prospective new students HCMS – 10:00am HCCA – 1:00 pm
February 28, 2018 – See the NOTE*	Lottery processing – 2:00 pm. The public is invited. Scheduled in Conference Room A – 6045 Buffington Road. Video taped session.
March 1, 2018	Tentative roster of prospective new students for 2018-2019 to be sent to FCBOE

NOTE*

If the total of the new enrollment registration numbers for 2018-2019 School Year plus the pre-enrollment (currently enrolled) registration number for 2017-2018 after the February 10, 2018 Informational/Application Meeting exceeds the maximum number of available seats (for grade levels 6 through 12) a lottery will be scheduled for all new enrollees at the middle school and/or at the high school by impacted grade level. The lottery will be conducted on February 28, 2018. Lottery Notifications of acceptances will be mailed to all applicants after March 10, 2018.

If the total of the new enrollment registration number for 2018-2019 plus the pre-enrollment (currently enrolled) registration number for 2017-2018 after the February 10, 2017 Informational/Application Meeting is equal to, or less than the maximum number of available seats (for grades 6 through 12), a lottery will not be conducted. All subsequent applications will be received as “first come, first serve” until the maximum enrollment level is attained for each of the grade levels. Acceptance letters will be mailed after March 10, 2018.
