Study Island	English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies	\$6205.50	Content teachers use Study Island for reinforcement of lessons and recovery. Teachers also use Study Island for assessments. Study Island assists with checks for understanding for TKES standards 5-6.
SWIVL	Instruction	\$1500	We use SWIVL to record our lessons for feedback and coaching from coaches and administrators. We also share the videos with all teachers.

FEV Tutor	English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies	\$16,000	FEV tutor provides virtual tutoring sessions for students. We use the program with Extended Learning and Saturday school to reinforce skills. We also use the program in summer school. Students access the tutors at home for homework assignments. FEV Tutor also assists with checks for understanding for TKES standards 5-6.
Extended Learning and Saturday School	Georgia Milestones courses	\$19,600	We offer Extended Learning on Monday and Tuesday and Saturday school to our students from October to April. We reserve two teachers for Math, Science, Social, Studies, and English Language Arts to provide one hour of instruction and three hours of instruction on Saturday. The program assists with checks for understanding for TKES standards 5-6.

USA Test Prep	English Language Arts, Math, Science, and Social Studies	\$8831.83	Teachers use USA Test prep in all subject areas for reinforcement and recovery. Teachers also use USA Test Prep for assessments and checks for understanding (TKES Standards 5-6). Additionally, special education teachers use USA Test Prep for data collection.
Amazon Edhesive Computer Science	Computer Science	\$0	This is a free partnership that we hope to continue with Amazon. We provide the teachers and computers. Students take Intro to Computer Science and AP Computer Science.
Princeton Review	SAT and ACT prep	\$75,000	Students have the opportunity to take ACT and SAT prep throughout the day and receive course credit. We have seen an increase in scores and our students are being accepted to more colleges and universities.

Naviance is needed for transcripts, academic guidance, career guidance, data collection, College & Career support, and GADOE Bridge Law
WriteScore	English Language Arts	\$3000	requirements. WriteScore is used for GA Milestones preparation. We receive one free administration from Fulton County Schools. We need 2-3 additional testing sessions. Write Score Assists with checks for understanding for TKES standards 5-6 in writing.
