About The Artist:

Tyler Whitlock is a self-taught artist. Drawing on influences ranging from the Old Masters to modern forms of digital and street art. His patented "glitch collage" style provides the basis for a presentation that pushes the boundaries of contemporary painting. Described as an emotionally charged outlet for social questions and critiques, his work often addresses topics of power, hypocrisy and the human condition.
