# INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

## INTERNSHIP DEFINED

- An experience in a career field of interest that is different than a part-time job
- An internship is meant to provide the student a more in-depth experience with a career or job type than a job shadowing experience
- An experience for high school students that will complement what they are learning in the classroom and increase their soft skills

## INTERNSHIP TYPES OFFERED BY BB2C

### SUPPORTIVE

- An educational experience where the student learns all they can about the position or line of work
- Soft skills are being developed under supervision
- Can be rotations in different departments (IE Hospital rotations)
- Discover what you like to do!

### INDEPENDENT

- A “second level” experience that is focused more on tasks or projects that are more defined by applying knowledge
- Soft skills are well-developed
- Working more independently
