INTERNSHIP DEFINED

- ▶ An experience in a career field of interest that is different than a part-time job
- ▶ An internship is meant to provide the student a more in-depth experience with a career or job type than a job shadowing experience
- ▶ An experience for high school students that will complement what they are learning in the classroom and increase their soft skills

Supportive

- ▶ An educational experience where the student learns all they can about the position or line of work
- ▶ Soft skills are being developed under supervision
- ▶ Can be rotations in different departments (IE Hospital rotations)

Independent

- ▶ A “next level” experience that is focused more on tasks or projects defined by applying knowledge
- ▶ Soft skills are well-developed and utilized for the task or project
- ▶ Working more independently
