From I-75



Take US 19/41 Business to intersection with SR 16 (Taylor Street). Turn left onto SR 16 (Taylor Street). Continue on SR 16 until it intersects with SR 155 (Hill Street) in Griffin. First Baptist Church is on the right.

From South:

Go North on US 341. Merge onto US 41 North. Go approximately 12 miles and turn right onto SR 155 (Zebulon Rd.). Continue approximately 4 miles. First Baptist Church is on the left.
