Banyam Theological Seminary is a three-year, degree-awarding school of the Nigerian United Methodist Church. Located in Bambur, one of the early mission stations, this large campus includes classrooms, the Bishop Rueben P. Job Library, the Streyffeler Chapel, staff and student housing. This seminary is one of the mission programs supported by the Iowa Nigeria Partnership. In our long partnership, the Iowa Annual Conference has supported Banyam Seminary through wells, library construction, chapel construction, computer lab, study bibles, scholarships, academic resources and faculty salary support.

"BTS is very significant in that this is the only seminary where we educate pastors and we send them to the field. The church in Nigeria is growing by 15 percent every year. And so we have a big challenge trying to produce manpower for the church."
