This National Cemetery was the first Veterans Affairs facility to built in Northeastern Ohio. The cemetery is planned to accommodate up to 175,000 interments in a variety of casketed, in-ground cremains, and columbarium sites.

We completed both the master plan and Phase I Development design and construction documents for this project. Major features built as part of Phase I include:

- 15,900 full-casket gravesites
- 3,000 columbarium niches
- Administration/maintenance complex
- Committal shelters
- Public information center
- Main entrance/Avenue of Flags
- Flag assembly area/rostrum
- Memorial walk
- Rain water harvesting and irrigation system

The project was completed under budget, allowing for an expedited development of the Phase II columbarium.
