Cleveland, Ohio: What started as a traditional landscape design project to highlight the historic preservation of a beautiful building became the lynch pin for a bigger campus plan called the Rockefeller Park Connector. Landscape design for this project included saving “Silver Park” while integrating it into the future plans for CWRU – Case Western Reserve University campus.

Constructed in 1924 and listed in the National Register of Historic Places, The Temple has had a significant religious and cultural presence on the University Circle landscape for generations. Its transformation into The Milton and Tamar Maltz Performing Arts Center at The Temple – Tifereth Israel preserves the iconic building and advances the university’s strategic emphasis on culture, creativity and design.
