Behnke redesigned the primary vehicular entry space, including the access drive, parking lot and entry plaza.

The project was funded by an Ohio Facilities Construction Commission (OFCC) Grant of \$750,000 and a Northeast Ohio Regional Sewer District (NEORS) Green Infrastructure Grant (which Behnke successfully applied for) of \$250,000.

Green infrastructure strategies utilized include pervious pavement, porous pipe, bioretention, and bottomless drainage structures. Parking improvements included a new parking control system, repaving and LED lighting. Construction was staged to keep the Society fully operational at all times during the ten month construction period.
