CONSTRUCTION AT THE CENTER FOR THE ARTS

We are in the process of building you a new, state of the art venue! Please pardon our dust and thank you for your understanding.

PARKING

1) In the parking lot across the street from the Center (6th and Whiterock with big horse sculpture)

2) Behind the Center - pull in rather than parallel park on 7th St

WHEELCHAIR ACCESSIBILITY

People using a wheelchair or with accessibility needs can be dropped off in front of the Center near the **ENTRANCE** sign. Please pull into this gravel access road, drop off, then reverse out the way you came - do not drive through access road.

ZERO-WASTE EVENT

CBFF is becoming Z-Life certified from Zoetica and need your help with our zero-waste efforts! Help us **ELIMINATE** single-use convenience trash by bringing your own water bottle. We'll have recycling and compost at all venues. ARE YOU A TICKET BUYER OR HAVE A 6-PACK?

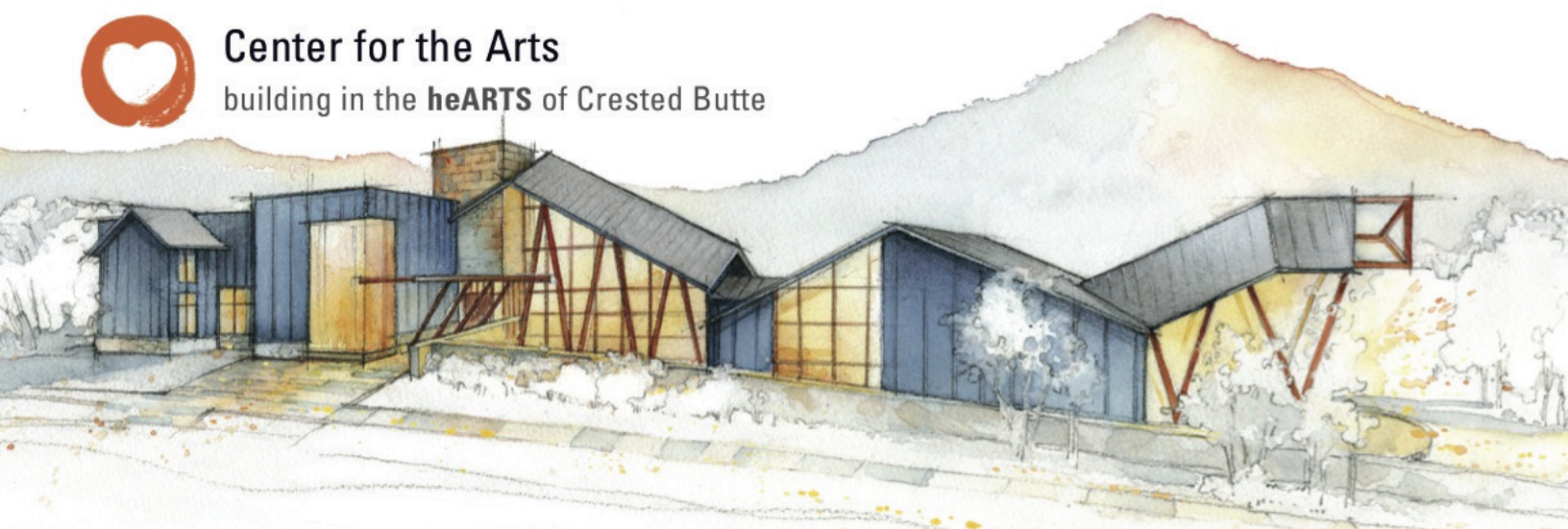
