He continues to visit Exodus to share updates, and to offer insight and encouragement to others experiencing the difficulties of the transition. Michael is currently employed by Mid-Hudson Regional Medical Center, employing the culinary skillset that he cultivated through his training and diligence. He is grateful to have had an outlet for growth, skill development, as well as a way to heal from the traumas of prison in a positive, transformative way.

Walking Through the Wilderness & Digital Skills

An employment readiness and life skills workshop for people returning home from incarceration. In this program, you will receive job readiness training, goal-setting around family & relationships, employment, education, housing, health & fitness, community involvement, and spirituality. Participants also receive digital and financial literacy.



Food Security

We offer hot meals for everyone who walks through our doors. We also have an on-site food pantry and food towers where we are growing our own produce to help combat hunger and food insecurity among our participants and their families.



Job Placement & Reentry Coaching

After completing Walking Through the Wilderness, you are matched with a reentry coach who helps you attain your goals and provides you with additional services and a job developer who helps you secure employment, provides interview clothing, assistance obtaining ID and other vital documents, and help with accessing benefits, housing, and other services as needed.

Jose, 45

Today is Jose's first birthday after serving 25 years in prison. Jose is a single father who came to Exodus to complete Anger Management for parole. He initially had no support and didn't even have his birth certificate after being released from prison. He struggled balancing his parole program requirements with taking care of his young children, but was able to complete his requirements and kept building towards his goals. He is working to get into the field of human services and work with at-risk youth and use his story to help keep them from ending up in prison.

Recovery Services, Case Management & Evidence Based Groups

We provide Anger Management, MRT, Ready, Set, work and other evidence based peer led groups, and partner with community-based organizations to provide quality recovery services, and relapse prevention.
