



GRANT APPLICATION

The Yellow Heart Trust was founded by Alex Fontaine in 2002 and she was awarded an MBE in 2007 for her work. People with financial restrictions, who need treatment for issues related to single-incident post-traumatic stress disorder and/or addiction, can apply for a grant. More than 450 people have been helped by The Yellow Heart Trust.

Am I eligible?

Please read through the following points to see if you qualify for a grant from the Yellow Heart Trust.

- Are you able to make some sort of financial contribution to your treatment?
- Do you have a specific need for treatment which is not provided by the NHS?
- Is your application supported by a qualified practitioner, i.e. your General Practitioner?

What can I apply for?

We currently have two funding schemes available:

The Antonio Vasconcellos Fund

Antonio Vasconcellos died, along with 50 others, on the occasion of his 26th birthday in the Marchioness Riverboat tragedy on the River Thames in 1989. A fund has been established in memory of this remarkable man who balanced a career as a successful fund manager with the roles of entrepreneur, writer, musician and philanthropist.

As so many of those who survived the sinking of the Marchioness benefited from post-traumatic stress disorder therapy, the fund's aim is to provide help for those coming to terms with unresolved issues resulting from single-incident trauma.

Rob's Wish Fund

The life experience of Rob Sparks, who was adopted at the age of 2, caused him to move to Bournemouth in his late 30s. Bournemouth was becoming known as an established centre for addiction rehabilitation, and Rob progressed to an excellent position with a pharmaceutical firm and embarked upon college studies to become a counsellor. In the third year of his studies his demons finally caught up with him and he lost his battle with alcohol. At the time of his death in January 2012, his dearest wish was to help others: "I want to help *people* not profit margins; to feel good about my life and help others feel good about theirs."

The aim of this fund is to support people who need therapy for addiction issues.

The Yellow Heart Trust has awarded grants for the treatment of depression, anxiety disorders, alcoholism, drug addiction and post-traumatic stress disorders.

Treatments received include:

- psychotherapy
- cognitive behaviour therapy (CBT)
- eye movement desensitization and reprocessing (EMDR) therapy
- trauma counselling
