

## About Our School

The Wyckoff Reformed Church Nursery School has been serving the community since 1973. We are committed to providing children aged 2 to 6 with a rewarding Christian educational program designed to develop mental, physical, social and emotional growth. Our curriculum provides a well balanced program which incorporates literacy, math, science, art, music and physical education.

Classes are offered in both the morning and the afternoon. These include enrichment opportunities for all children over the age of 2 ½ as well as lunch programs. All classrooms are large, well lit and securely located above street level. An added level of confidence is provided by our state of the art security system which requires all visitors to be screened before entry.

The Wyckoff Reformed Church Nursery School provides a warm nurturing environment for children to grow. Our goal is to encourage curiosity, self-direction and confidence through social development and academic maturity.

## Registration

Registration begins in January. In order to enroll your child in the WRC Nursery School please submit the following:

- \$60 non-refundable application fee. One per family.
- Deposit of one-tenth tuition

Advance tuition is refundable only for withdrawals received by June 30, 2016.

## Tuition

Tuition payments are due September 1, December 1 and March 1.

- A late fee will be assessed for delinquent payments.
- Payment plans can be arranged as needed.

No adjustments will be made for absences (sickness or vacation).

## Classes Available

### Mommy and Me

**18 months and older 9:00 – 11:00am**

These classes are designed to give moms the opportunity to interact with their children and other moms through crafts, music, Bible stories and games.

**Tots 9:00 – 11:30am**

**\*Must be 2 by 10/1 2 day (T, Th)  
3 day (M, W, F)**

This class begins with a focus on independence and socialization. As the school year progresses, language development and sharing improve. The children also begin to follow simple instructions to prepare for the Nursery class.

**Nursery 9:00 – 11:30am**

**\*Must be 3 by 10/1 3 day (M, W, F)  
4 day (M-Th)**

This class begins with a focus on socialization, language development and listening skills. These skills allow the children to progress in letter and number recognition as well as small and large motor development. The curriculum includes literacy, reading readiness, math readiness, art and music.

**Pre-K 9:00 – 11:30am**

**\*Must be 4 by 10/1 4 day (M, T, Th, F)  
5 day (M-F)**

This class utilizes the Houghton Mifflin Math and Literacy Program. The thematic curriculum includes alphabet and number recognition, and reading, writing and math readiness. Smart boards are used regularly to incorporate the latest technology in everyday lessons.

### Transitional Kindergarten

In order to prepare the children for the public schools, we are offering a 2/3 Day schedule similar to the Wyckoff Public Schools which includes two long days and three short days.

## Enrichment

### Six-Week Lunch Programs

**\*Must be 2 ½**

**Lunch Only 11:30am-12:15pm**

**Lunch and Play 11:30am-2:00pm**

These programs provide children the opportunity to extend the school day while socializing with their peers. Parents provide lunch.

**LO and Learn 11:30am-1:00pm**

**Lunch and Learn 11:30am-2:45pm**

This class is a hands-on, thematic-based program run in conjunction with our lunch program. Each session the children will explore different topics through books, projects, experiments and computers. Parents provide lunch.

### Pre-K Enrichment

**Tuesday 11:30 – 2:45pm**

The children explore different topics through books, projects, experiments and computers. The children will have the opportunity to enjoy lunch with their classmates. Parents provide lunch.

### Power Up for Kindergarten

**Thursday (Jan – May) 11:30 – 2:45pm**

This class is more academically focused to help prepare children for the transition to kindergarten. Reading/writing workshop is explored as well as handwriting skills and basic math concepts. Parents provide lunch.
