Small wooden building , East side of road near present junction Hwy. 21 and Blythewood Road. Furman Hood, Postmaster.

A section of the old G. Y. Langford and Sons general store, West side hwy. 21 near present driveway leading to rear of the S. C. National Bank.

Old Brooks Brown store building, parallel to and South of Langford Road, East of Southern Railway Crossing.

Rear portion of Dr. Mike Langford's medical office.

Later in front portion of same building.

Mrs Frances Powell Langford's building West side Hwy. 21.

The brick building on McNulty Ave. (1969)

Present location corner Boney Road and McNulty Ave. (1991)

No information available prior to 1900.

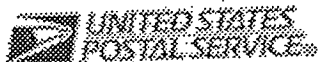

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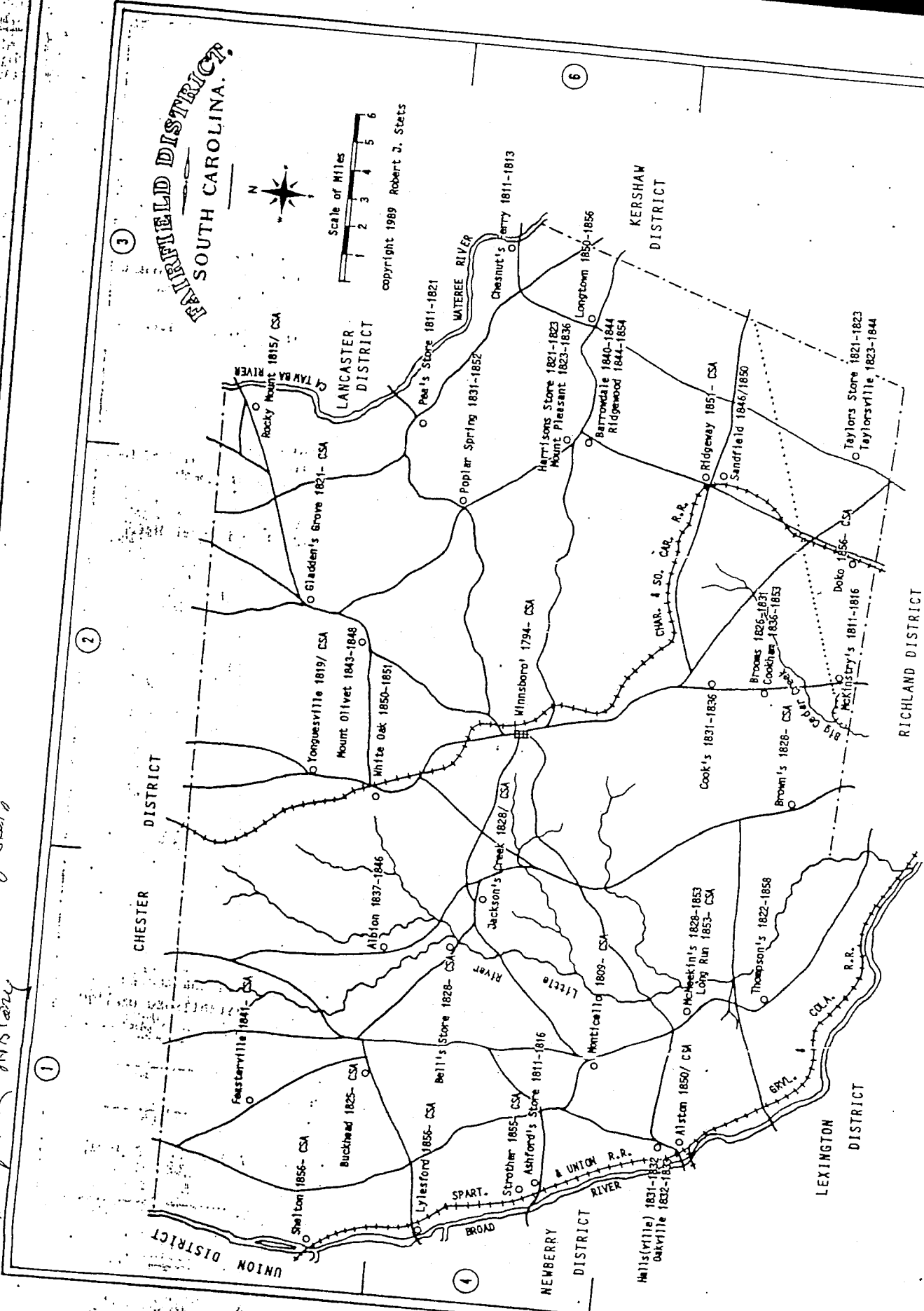

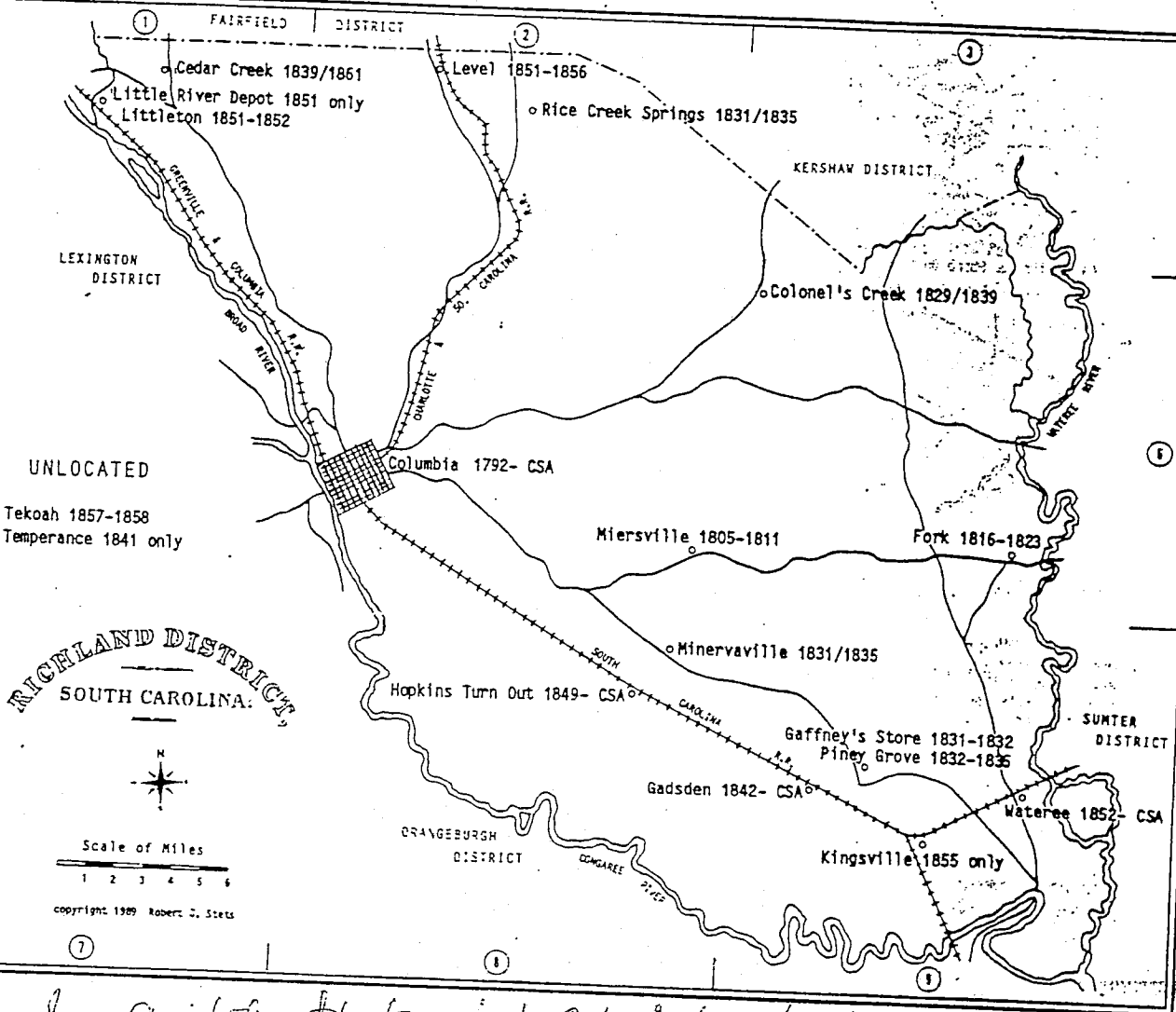
