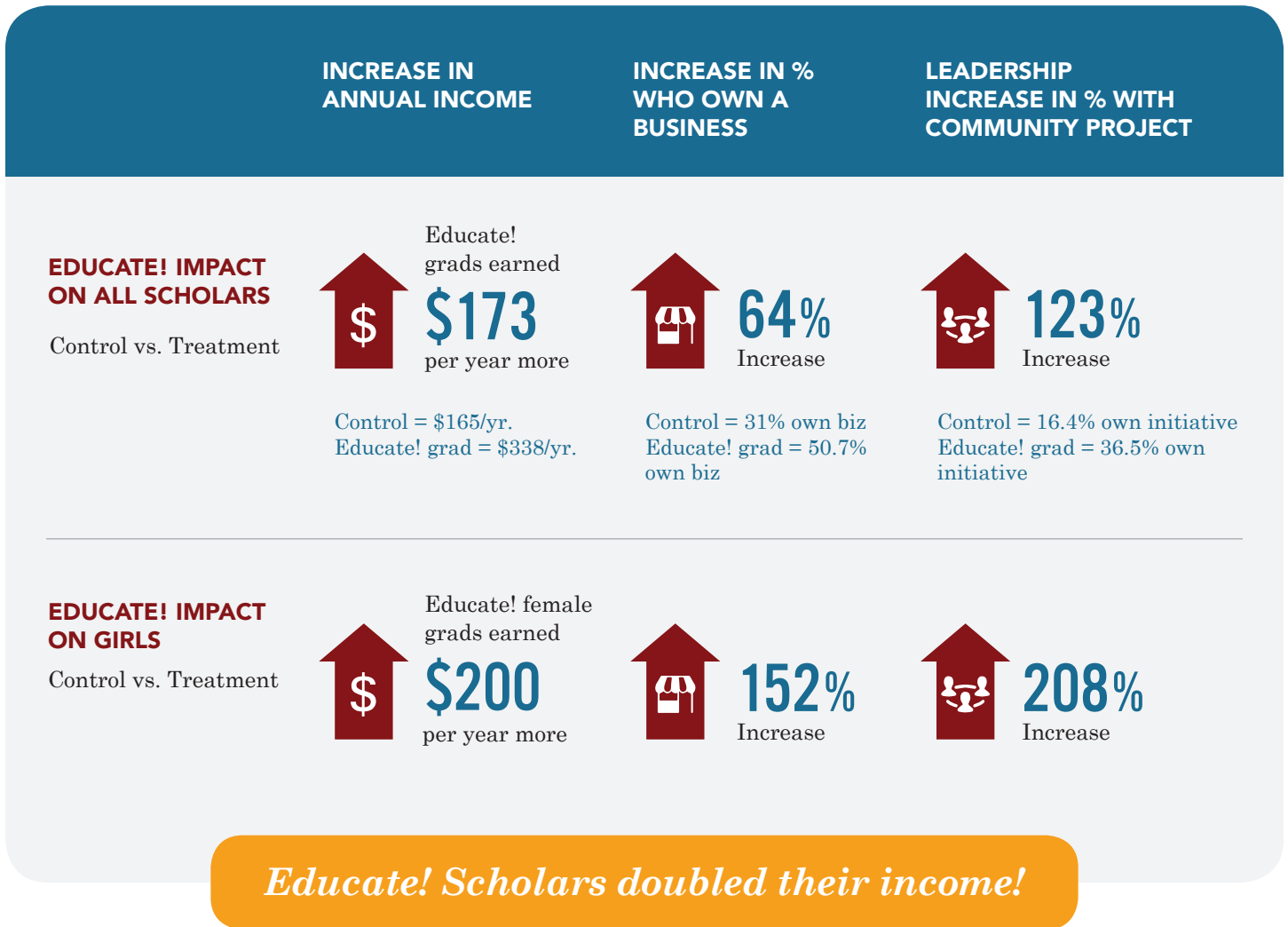


Educate!'s Monitoring and Evaluation team, in partnership with Innovations for Poverty Action, conducted a randomized controlled trial of the Educate! Experience program in Uganda.

In 2014, after the full two-year program, we saw the following effects:



SAVINGS BEHAVIOR



Educate! graduates scored
20.4% HIGHER
than the Control Group on a scale measuring their savings behavior



Educate! female graduates scored
46.6% HIGHER
than the Female Control Group on a scale measuring their savings behavior

*The income results shown here were determined using regression analysis.
All other results were determined using descriptive statistics.*
