

Resolution #2

Reserve Fund Reallocation for the Purchase of Computers

- Author(s): Legislative Vice President Whelton, Communications Vice President Lahr
- Sponsor(s): President Schultz, Executive Vice President Bowman, Financial Vice President Johnson, Programs Vice President Tucky
- Whereas: Up to date and functioning office computers are necessary for MUSG to properly fulfill its duties; and,
- Whereas: Six computers in the MUSG office are currently up for replacement by the University Computer Replacement program; and,
- Whereas: There are insufficient funds in the technology budget line for the replacement of the computers; and,
- Whereas: This is a capital investment for the good of the office; and,
- Whereas: "The reserve fund shall be available to purchase capital goods or other office related equipment for MUSG;"<sup>1</sup> and,
- Therefore: Let it be resolved that MUSG will reallocate \$1,739 from the Reserve Fund into the technology budget line for the purchase of new office computers.
