### MUSG's Endorsement of the Academic Integrity Steering Committee

- Whereas: MUSG serves to actively identify, understand, address, and represent student's needs, concerns, and interests through acts of leadership and service that reflect Catholic, Jesuit ideals; and,
- Whereas: As stated in the Undergraduate Bulletin, "As an institution of higher education, love of truth is at the center of the university's enterprise, and academic honesty, in all its forms, is an explicit value of the university<sup>1</sup>;" and,
- Whereas: On April 24<sup>th</sup>, 2014, Dr. Gary Meyer, Vice Provost for Undergraduate Programs and Teaching, and Dr. Peter Toumanoff presented to Senate and informed the body of their most recent Academic Integrity initiatives; and,
- Whereas: In 2011, MUSG passed Resolution #1 "Supporting the Academic Subcommittee's Recommendation to Improve Academic Integrity."
- Therefore: MUSG endorses the ongoing work of the Academic Integrity Steering Committee around Educational Materials, Honor Code, and Honor Council; and,
- Furthermore: MUSG recommends that the Statement on Academic Integrity be integrated into appropriate university documentation (e.g., Student Handbook, Undergraduate Bulletin, Graduate Bulletin).
