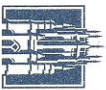

Whereas: It is the role of Marquette University Student Government (MUSG) to actively identify, understand, address, and represent students' needs, concerns, and interests; and,

Whereas: Marquette University strives to develop men and women who will dedicate their lives to the service of others¹ and for the betterment of the surrounding community; and,

Whereas: MUSG aims to embrace this mission by forming an ongoing partnership with the Center for Community Service at Marquette, as well as, the Avenues West Neighborhood Association; and,

Whereas: In order to further MUSG's partnership with the Avenues West Association and our surrounding neighborhood, a Neighborhood Clean-up day has been planned for Sunday November 2nd; and,

Whereas: The Neighborhood cleanup initiative has gained the approval and support of university administration, surrounding landlords and property owners, Department of Public Safety and Milwaukee Police Department, as well as, other key community stakeholders; and

Whereas: This initiative will be a community building opportunity for all stakeholders to come together and foster a stronger neighborhood through more personal relationships.

Therefore: Let it be resolved that MUSG allocate a total of \$520.00 from the Reserve Fund for the catering costs of the morning beverages and the Community Building Luncheon to take place after the Neighborhood Clean-up efforts are completed.
