

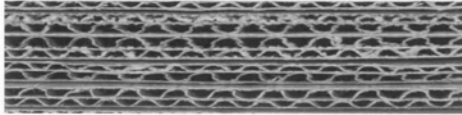

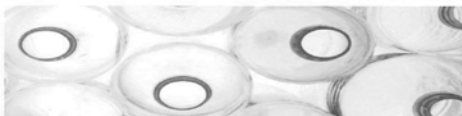
CARDBOARD

Cereal Boxes, Pizza Boxes, Paper Towel Cores, Egg Cartons, Beverage Holders



PAPER

Newspapers, Junk Mail, Envelopes, Magazines, Soft Cover Books, Brown Bags



PLASTIC

Containers #1 - #7 (Milk Jugs, Bleach, Detergent, Shampoo Bottles, Etc.)



GLASS

Bottles and Containers (Any Color)



METAL

Aluminum, Tin, Steel Kitchen Cans, Aluminum Pie Plates/Trays/Foil

<p>BRUSH COLLECTION SCHEDULE:</p>	<p>November 1 - March 31: No regular pick-up. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please call Buildings & Grounds (716)-357-6208 April 1 - October 31:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Rake into street along the curb by 7:00 AM • Piles must be light enough for one person to lift. • Contractors must pick-up and haul away large debris piles outside the community landscape clean out weeks. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Large debris piles created by landscape contractors. 2. Bagged or potted material. 3. Material NOT along street curb 4. Requires more than 1 person to lift.

<p><u>COMMUNITY LANDSCAPE CLEAN-OUT WEEKS :</u> Larger brush/garden refuse collection weeks.</p> <p>During these weeks ONLY landscapers may leave debris from CI properties to be picked up by Gardens & Grounds Departments.</p>	<p><u>8 WEEKS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 2nd & 4th FULL weeks of April/May • 2nd FULL week of June/July/August • 4th FULL week of September <p><u>REGULATIONS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • PLEASE rake into the street along the curb by 7:00 AM DAILY • Separate sticks/branches from leaves/grass clippings/foilage • NO BRANCHES longer than 6ft in length 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Large root balls 2. Branches longer than 6ft in length. 3. Soil or old mulch.
<p><u>COMMUNITY HOUSEHOLD CLEAN-UP DAYS:</u> Bulk Items & Electronics Recycling</p>	<p><u>SCHEDULE:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • SPRING : 1st Wednesday of June • FALL: 1st Wednesday after Labor Day • Items to the curb by 7:00 AM <p><u>BULK ITEM REGULATIONS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • NO BRUSH, LEAVES OR LANDSCAPE DEBRIS • Sort into 3 piles: metals, wood products and household refuse. • Piles must be light enough for one person to lift. <p><u>ELECTRONICS:</u></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Please drop-off items on the north side of the Colonnade. • CI Staff will be on hand to help unload heavy items • NO CONSOLE TELEVEISIONS ACCEPTED • Refrigerators MUST be emptied of Freon. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1.
