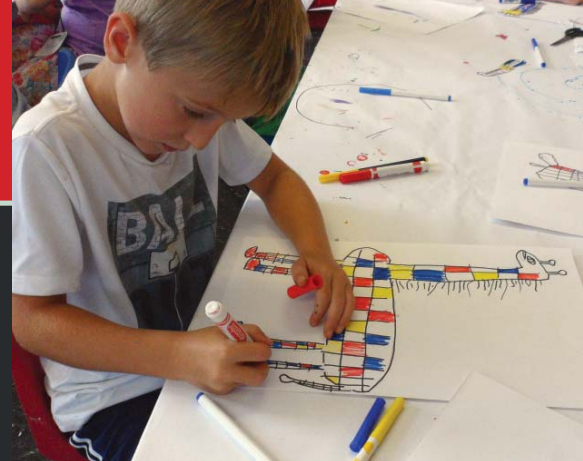
Pint Size Picassos

Artist Jonathan Brilliant transforms HMA's Coe Gallery into an art installation using to-go coffee accessories. The centerpiece is a colossal sculpture created by weaving 50,000+ wood coffee stirrers together with no adhesive. **See him working live April 26 - May 4.** A hands-on area allows visitors to creatively use to-go cups, sleeves, stirrers and more. Exhibition runs through September 9.

Art Safari

Imagine a herd of giraffes on the horizon, a tiger cub in the grass. Campers will create flamingos, zebras, snakes and other projects inspired by wild things.

Circus Circus

Join the HMA circus for a week of clowning around. A different circus-related project will have campers creating lions, elephants, acrobats and more. A variety of materials and techniques will be used.

Clay Creations

Design and create wonderful hand-built pottery. Learn various techniques such as coil, pinch pot, and clay impression to make animal pots, wacky mask and more. Create with Sculpey clay and paper clay. Experiment with regular glazes and underglazes for decoration. *Pottery will be fired and ready to pick up the following week.*

Crazy for Carle

Young artists will be inspired each day by a different Eric Carle story. Make your own play dough like *Walter the Baker*, create textured collages using paint and tissue paper, go under the sea with *Mr. Seahorse*, and make a crazy cat from *"Have you seen My Cat?"*

Dragons & Fairies

Enter a magical forest of dancing frogs and friendly dragons. Create a princess crown and a wizard wand, fairy/dragon wings, and shields. Make a flying dragon, become a king or queen for the day and have your picture taken on a giant royal throne.

Drawing & Painting Animals

Learn to draw and paint animals of all shapes and sizes. Start with sketches and fill with oil pastels, watercolor and paint. Learn about their habitats and place them in environments. Visit Catawba Science Center to sketch animals in the naturalist center, then come back and color your sketch with acrylic paints.

Earth Art

Create art that comes from the earth and art that will save the earth! Make nature prints, seed mosaics and pine cone owls, along with art created using recycled materials.

Fantastic Folk Art

In the Southern tradition, students will make a face jug that will be fired and glazed, use the folk art style of simple painting on a piece of wood, use found objects to create a mixed media piece of artwork, textile weavings and more.

Frozen

It's hot outside, but cold in this camp. Create snowmen, (Olaf), snow dough, sparkling princesses and winter artwork. Take the entire week to cool off.

Globe Trekker

Grab your creative passport and make art from around the globe. Practice drawing Russian architecture, craft a Japanese fish kite and an African mask. Make dream catchers, totem poles and more.

Lights, Camera, Action!

This drama camp invites you to act out a short play and perform it in Drendel Auditorium (on the SALT Block) for families on Friday. Create scenery, decide on props and create simple costumes. Perfect for all those drama queens and kings!

Mini Masters

Pick up your brush and paint masterpieces in the style of great artists. Paint flowers using Van Gogh's choppy strokes, Picasso's cubist faces, Matisse collages and pastels like Georgia O'Keefe. Paint a mini-canvas as a final masterpiece.

Monsters & Zombies

Monsters don't have to be scary; they can be fun and imaginative. Examine the world of monsters, zombies, and vampires within children's literature while using them as inspiration for mixed-media art-making. Create monster art by using various painting, printmaking, collage and sculpture techniques. Bring your creature to life!

Museum Sleuth

Begin each day deciphering clues that lead you on a search through the Museum for a specific piece of artwork. The art project for the day will then be designed around what has been uncovered. Make wacky folk art, unusual faces, 3D art and more.

Ocean Treasures

Don't miss this deep sea adventure as we paint sea creatures, and tropical fish, make 3D jellyfish and aquariums, create mermaids, sea turtles, and more. A variety of art techniques will be used.

Photo Art

Bring your iPad or digital camera and get ready for some photo fun. Explore the grounds and participate in photo scavenger hunts, make photomontages, sun prints, and a photo diorama. Take selfies, print them and add color using colored pencils. A wide array of experimental photography art will be explored.

Sculpture

Explore the world of sculpture through a variety of media including clay, wire, foil, found objects and more. Experiment with a range of techniques and materials to create sculptural works of art.

Secret Garden

Campers will make arts and crafts inspired by the natural environment. From earthworms and insects, to rainbows and butterflies, we'll cultivate creativity and harvest some fun!

Sizzlin' Summer Sampler

Try your hand at a variety of materials. Paint, create with clay, make sculptures and print during this eclectic camp for creative exploration.

Super Heroes & Fairytales

Become your favorite super hero or fairytale character as we make masks and capes. Hear stories and make simple puppets of beloved fairytale characters. We will paint and create in this super fantastic week.
