MIDDLE SCHOOL (GRADES 6-8)

NEW STUDENTS-

Will be greeted at main entrance or café and directed to Main Conference Hall (A) for “Welcome Process”

- *Check in and obtain 1st Period Class Teacher Assignment
- *Meet SMSA Middle School and Administrative staff for a short “orientation”
- *Students will travel from Conference Hall as a group with period 1 teacher.
- *ALL students will be provided a **free school lunch**

RETURNING STUDENTS-

Will be directed to the Main Gymnasium to meet their 1st Block Teacher.

- *Students will check in and be informed of their Block 1 Teacher
- *Students will be seated in designated areas of the gymnasium supervised by their Block 1st teacher
- *Students will travel as a group up to Block 1 Class with their teacher

HIGH SCHOOL (GRADES 9-12)

NEW STUDENTS-

Will be greeted at main entrance or Café and directed to Main Conference Hall (B) for “Welcome Process”

- *Check in and obtain Class Schedule
- *Meet SMSA High School and administrative staff that will answer questions
- *Meet SMSA High School students that will direct/accompany new student to their Block 1 Class.
- *SMSA Staff will be available throughout the building assisting students with classroom locations and other supports
- *ALL students will be provided a **free school lunch**

RETURNING STUDENTS-

Will be directed to the FIELD HOUSE to meet staff who will distribute schedules or student’s Block 1 Class.

- *Students will be directed to report to their Block 1 Class by 7:45 a.m.
