



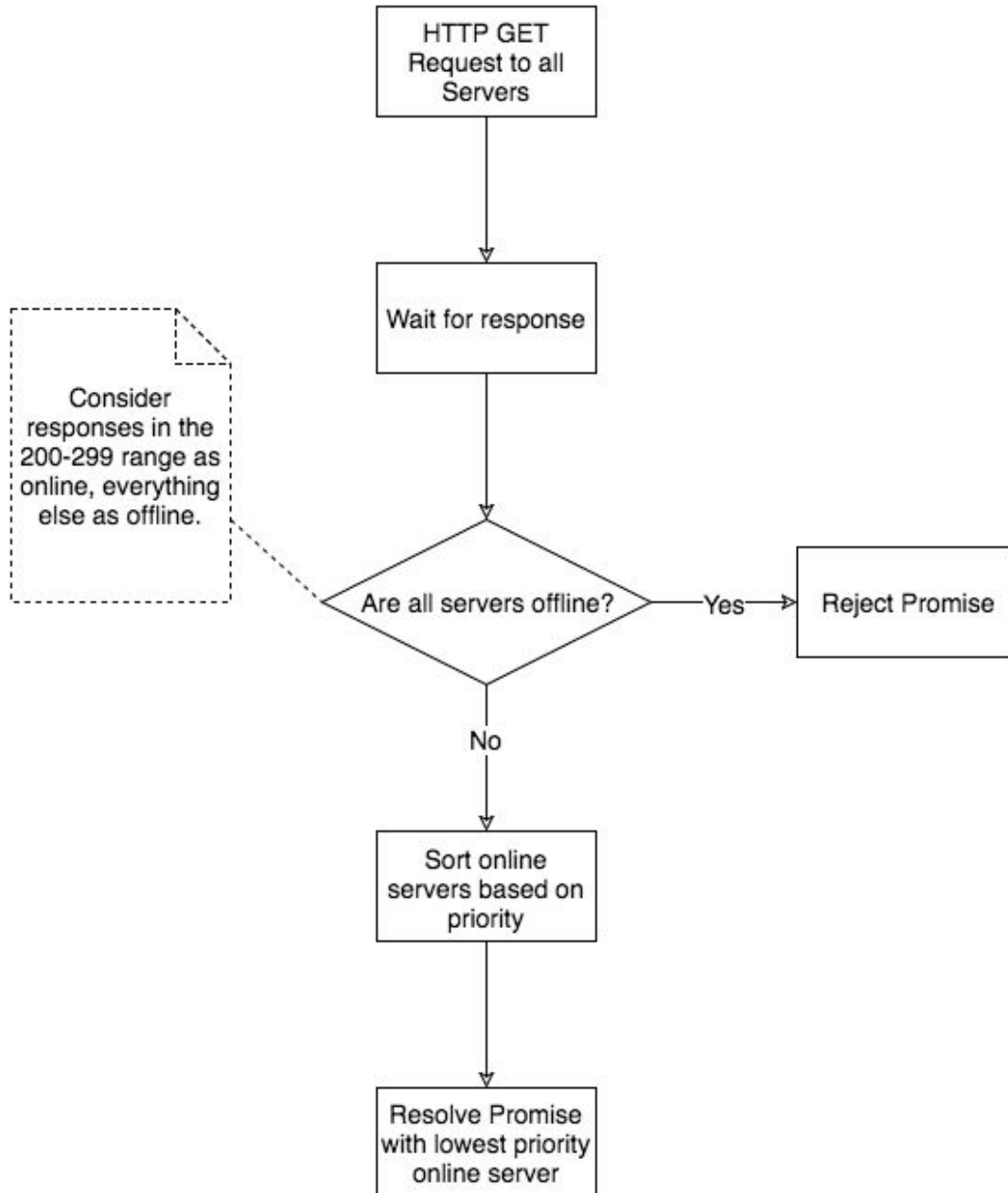

Angular JS Developer Assignment

Overview:

You are tasked to create an Angular (v1) service, that determines the availability of a given list of servers and then returns an available server with the lowest priority number. Additionally you should create sufficient unit tests for this service.



Requirements:

1. Angular Service with a `findServer()` function which should return a Promise that either:
 - a. Resolves with the online server that has the lowest priority number.
 - b. Rejects with an error, if no Servers are online.
2. HTTP GET requests should be used to determine if a server is online or offline additionally the following is required:
 - a. Use Angular's [\\$http](#) Service for the requests.
 - b. All GET requests should be done simultaneously.
 - c. A GET request should timeout after 5 seconds.
 - d. A server should be considered online if it's response status code is between 200 and 299.
3. Unit Tests are required to sufficiently test all components of your service. Additionally the following is required for unit tests:
 - a. All server interaction should be mocked with Angular's [\\$httpBackend](#).
