

American History II Description: This course will cover American History from the latter half of the 19th Century to present day events.

Course Requirements:

- **Homework:** I will give out assignment sheets at the beginning of each unit. As the lessons progress, I will establish due dates for each assignment on the sheet. If you would like to get ahead on your homework, feel free to do so but please only hand in what is due on the assigned dates. If you put effort into your homework assignment, you will receive credit. If you give me substandard work or neglect to hand in your assignment you will receive no credit. Late assignments will be accepted up to 3 school days following its due date for a partial credit. No penalty will be given for homework handed in late as a result of an absence.
- **Tests and Quizzes:** Quizzes are based on class lessons and homework. They will be given at least once a week. I will generally announce a quiz the day before but reserve the right to give a “pop” quiz if I feel it is necessary. Tests will be given around every two weeks and will always be announced ahead of time. All missed quizzes and tests must be made up.
- **Projects:** A year-long project will start during the first trimester. The final project will be worth two test grades for the third trimester.
