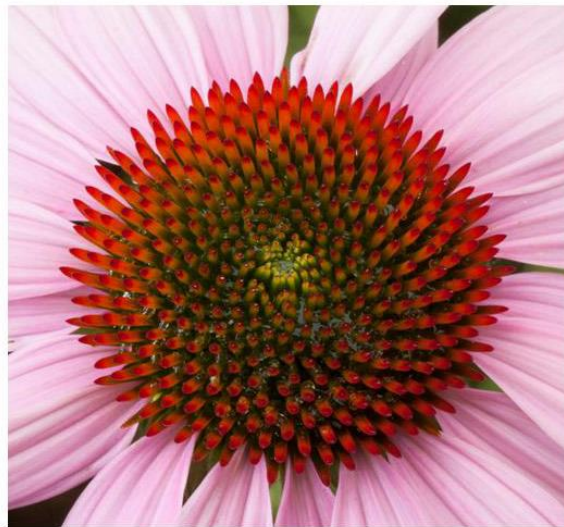

ANNUAL MEMBERSHIP CAMPAIGN GETS UNDERWAY

Our membership drive begins NOW! You will receive your renewal notice early in October, as usual, and most of you know how important it is to get your payment back by the third week in October. Bulk mailing your new cards at the end of that month saves us hundreds of dollars.

DUES INCREASE THIS YEAR

This year, for only the third time in FOBG's history, we have increased our basic membership dues. The Sponsor (\$100+), Patron (\$250+), and Benefactor (\$500+) categories are unchanged. The Contributor category is being eliminated. And Individual, Family, and Garden Club memberships will increase to \$45, \$60, and \$60, respectively--about a third. These changes are expected to raise an additional \$7,000 for Brookside Gardens. Our dues will now be in line with similar organizations. Besides, don't most of us join FOBG mainly to support the programs and plantings of Brookside Gardens anyway?

OUR GOAL: 1,000 MEMBERS


Brookside Gardens gets more than 400,000 visitors annually, but FOBG has fewer than 900 members. Help us reach our goal of 1,000 members this year. Every new member who joins FOBG between August and October gets a bonus: the membership will continue through October 2015. Do you have friends or neighbors who are not members of FOBG?
