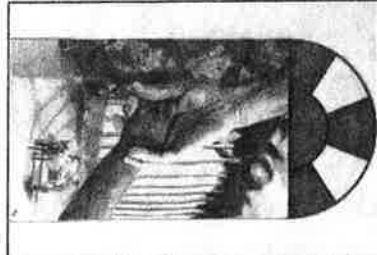


World Day of Prayer 2016

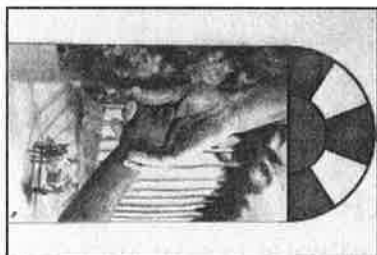
