MINNEAPOLIS, MN - Twin Cities-based singer/songwriter Jonathan Rundman will perform at the Cedar Cultural Center in Minneapolis on June 29th. The show celebrates **Rundman’s 25th anniversary** as a full-time touring and recording artist, and launches his new 22-song retrospective album *Reservoir*. Rundman will be opening the show for Cincinnati-based Americana band The Tillers.

Reservoir collects Jonathan Rundman's best songs from the albums *Sound Theology* (2000), *Public Library* (2004), *Insomniaccomplishments* (2008), and *Look Up* (2015), in celebration of the 25th anniversary of his recording career. Also included are three previously unreleased tracks: a new remix of "Local Road," the four-track cassette recording "Robert Traver Blues," and a live recording of "The Prophetstown Tornado."

(Rundman's previously released compilation ***20 Songs From The 20th Century*** collects his best songs from 1992-1999.)

Rundman has spent the past eight months touring in Europe and across North America. In October of 2016 he performed at the Lost In Music Festival in Tampere, Finland, toured in his ancestral hometowns, and appeared on a music industry panel at Finland's Music & Media conference. American tour dates included stops in California, Wisconsin, Kentucky, Ohio, Illinois, New Jersey, Connecticut, and Nebraska. Prior to his 25th anniversary show at the Cedar Cultural Center in Minneapolis, Rundman will be performing in Germany from June 19-25, 2017, at the Luther500 Festival in Wittenberg.

Rundman's critically acclaimed power-pop anthems navigate the uncharted spaces between midcentury heartland twang, '80s New Wave, and archaic Euro-folk.
