Funding for Phase IV of houses at Hawthorn Glen has been approved! In September, the Federal Home Loan Bank of Indianapolis granted \$500,000 for four more homes in Hawthorn Glen and [Your Community Bank](#) provided a charitable contribution toward their development. We learned yesterday that the Indiana Housing and Community Development Authority (IHCDA) awarded the remaining \$550,000 needed to complete this phase of homes! Around this time next year, 12 more individuals with disabilities will be moving into beautiful, fully accessible new homes.

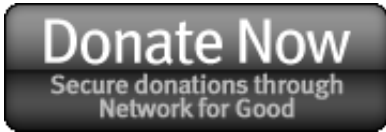
